It's Law!

The International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code requires that all personnel involved in the transport of dangerous goods by sea, should receive training. South African maritime legislation in the form of the Merchant Shipping (Carriage of Cargoes) Regulations, 2004, incorporates the requirements of the IMDG Code into South African law.

Course content and objectives
